IT PM Training

- OFPP (*Office of Federal Procurement Policy*) has issued a revised [FAC-P/PM policy](#). This policy went into effect on March 31, 2014
 - HHS is still in the process of revising the HHS FAC-P/PM Handbook to support this revised policy.
 - Existing certified P/PM will be grandfathered at the same level under the new program.
 - Level II and Level III IT P/PMs will be required to gain “Core Plus” IT Specialization after obtaining basic certification – more details to come.
