# PMP Certification Updates

- 2015 Continuing Certification Requirements (CCR) Program Updates
  - PMP Exam Changes in 2016
    - The five domains of practice for the PMP remain the same. However, tasks within each domain have been modified, added, or removed. Addition of 8 new tasks.
    - Exam Content Outline:

    - The current exam (aligned to the existing exam content outline) will remain active until 11 January 2016
    - After 11 January 2016, only the new version of the PMP exam will be administered.

# PMP Certification: What's New in the CCR Program

- The overall framework of the CCR program remains the same. You will continue to earn PDUs in the categories of Education and Giving Back.
  - **How** PDUs in those categories are classified will be different.
  - Education
    - 60% of PDUs are now required in this category to place more emphasis on developing employer-demanded skills.
    - Education PDUs are aligned with the PMI Talent Triangle.
    - A *minimum* number of PDUs must be earned in Technical Project Management, Leadership, and Strategic and Business Management categories.
  - Giving Back
    - The maximum number of total PDUs to be earned in this category has decreased.
    - Activities remain the same: Volunteering, Creating Knowledge and Working as a Professional.
    - The total number of PDUs to be earned in Working as a Professional has decreased.

# PMP Certification: CCR Program Updates -Timeline

- There are different renewal requirements for the Education and Giving Back categories based on the expiration date of the certification cycle. Please refer to the table.

Beginning 1 December 2015	Certification Expiration Date:	
	1 December 2015 – 30 November 2017	1 December 2017 and Beyond
Classify PDUs according to new CCR format.	Yes	Yes
Meet minimum number of PDUs in Education category and each of the three skill areas. This is required for renewal.	No*	Yes
Limit Giving Back category PDUs to new maximum requirement.	No*	Yes

\* Compliance with the new format is encouraged, but not mandatory to renew during the current cycle. In future cycles, the new CCR program requirements must be satisfied to maintain active certification status.
